

Advertisement of Public Bid

The District Board of Trustees of Florida Gateway College will receive bids for the following PROJECT:

Project Description:

The work to be completed under this contract generally includes, but is not limited to, the following: New infrastructure and facilities on undeveloped Olustee campus property including a 3,000 SF training building, 280,000 SF asphalt driving pad, asphalt access road and parking area, potable water supply, septic system and drainfield, electric supply, and installation of stormwater control structures.

Grant Funded:

This project will be partially funded with Federal funds from the United States Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration and therefore is subject to the Federal laws and regulations associated with that program.

Bid Security:

Each bid must be accompanied by a bid security in the form of either a Certified Check, Cashier's Check, Treasurer's Check, Bank Draft or Bid Bond in the amount of, not less than, five percent (5%) of the maximum amount bid as a guarantee that the Bidder, if awarded the contract, will (within ten (10) calendar days after written notice being given of such award) enter into a written contract with the District Board of Trustees of Florida Gateway College in accordance with the accepted bid and give a surety bond satisfactory to the District Board of Trustees of Florida Gateway College equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the Contract Price. Bidders withdrawing their bids within thirty (30) days after the date of the bid opening shall forfeit their bid security.

Public Construction Bond:

A Public Construction Bond will be required of the successful Bidder. The bond shall equal one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount and shall be with a surety insurer authorized to do business in Florida and complying with Section 255 Florida Statutes.

Payment and Performance Bond:

A Payment and Performance Bond is required for one hundred percent (100%) of the contract amount from the successful bidder.

Contractor's Prequalification:

All prime Contractors who wish to bid this project must be prequalified. Contractors who wish to submit a bid on this project must prequalify with Florida Gateway College. To be considered for prequalification, Contractors must request, complete and submit a prequalification package to the College.
