GPA requirement: 3.0 for college credit courses, 2.0 for CTE clock hour courses

## Academic Integrity

Along with GPA, college level scores on placement tests are required for college level courses. For CTE clock hour courses, certain scores on the Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) are required.\*

\*Some CTE programs may be available to students who are in their senior year of high school and have not met minimum test scores on the TABE.

## Testing & Support

FGC now offers free placement testing to all high school students interested in Dual Enrollment. If minimum scores are not met, our staff will assist you in reaching them through diagnostic testing and a free preparatory course.



## High School Requirements

Check with your guidance counselor on any other requirements to participate. Schools sometimes require parent meetings prior to approval for dual enrollment program.
